
In 1997, our terminally ill 12 year-old son, Dash, received his wish from Make-A-Wish of Oregon - a **laptop computer**. It enabled him to keep himself entertained and distracted as he endured long weeks of surgeries and aggressive treatment at Doernbecher Children's Hospital in Portland. After a 19 month battle, Dash died from his brain tumor on February 2, 1999. After his death, we established a pediatric cancer research endowment at OHSU in Portland. It was Dash's desire for other children with malignant tumors to have hope of a better life.

Now, nearly nine years since Dash's death, our hearts have been turned to Make-A-Wish. Since we now live in Idaho, we chose to donate our home in Eagle to the local foundation. The transfer of title was completed on December, 31, 2007 and we are happy to be able to make this contribution to MAW. We understand that the house will be sold by auction.

Our desire would be for the proceeds of the auction to be invested to earn income to fund wishes each year. Hopefully, the principal amount will not be spent, that it can remain invested in order to perpetuate the gift. Ultimately, we know that you will be wise stewards and make decisions that best benefit wish kids and help their dreams come true.
